FACTS

University of Maryland Shore Regional Health is the principal provider of comprehensive health care services for more than 170,000 residents of Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne’s and Talbot counties on Maryland’s Eastern Shore. UM Shore Regional Health operates three hospitals, a freestanding emergency center, an acute rehabilitation center, outpatient care centers and home care services throughout the region. Affiliated with UM SRH is UM Shore Medical Group, which includes more than 100 physician and advanced practice providers in 20-plus primary care and specialty practices throughout the five county region.



A COORDINATED HEALTH CARE NETWORK

University of Maryland Shore Regional Health was formed July 1, 2013, when Shore Health and Chester River Health, which both had been affiliated as members of the University of Maryland Medical System (UMMS), merged to form one coordinated network within UMMS.

The mission of UM Shore Regional Health, **Creating Healthier Communities Together**, reflects the organization’s goal of providing quality health care services that are comprehensive, accessible and convenient, and that address the health care needs of the region.

UM Shore Regional Health is an **integral member of UMMS** and is closely affiliated with the University of Maryland Medical Center for patients who need more complex care.

UM Shore Regional Health offers **home-based services** throughout its service area through UM Chester River Home Care and UM Shore Home Care.

University of Maryland Shore Regional Health comprises:

- University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown
- University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Dorchester (this facility will close once UM Shore Medical Campus at Cambridge, offering emergency and outpatient care, opens in fall 2021).
- University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton
- University of Maryland Shore Emergency Center at Queenstown
- UM Shore Medical Pavilions at Chestertown, Denton, Dorchester, Easton and Queenstown
- A host of outpatient, rehabilitation and diagnostic facilities including the Cancer Center, the Clark Comprehensive Breast Center, the Diagnostic and Imaging Center and the Orthopedic Center.

AWARD-WINNING CARE

UM Shore Medical Center at Easton is designated as a **Primary Stroke Center** by the Maryland Institute for Emergency Services Systems (MIEMSS). The Stroke Center also has received the Gold Plus Achievement Award from the American Stroke Association/American Heart Association (ASA/AHA), and earned ASA/AHA *Get with the Guidelines* Honor Roll Elite Plus status.

The **Cardiac and Pulmonary Rehabilitation Programs** at University of Maryland Shore Medical Centers at Chestertown, Dorchester and Easton are certified by the American Association of Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation (AACVPR).

The Easton location of the **Clark Comprehensive Breast Center** is fully accredited by the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers (NAPBC), a program administered by the American College of Surgeons.

UM Shore Regional Health's **Cancer Program** is accredited by the Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons.

The **Requard Center for Acute Rehabilitation** at UM Shore Medical Center at Easton and its **Stroke Specialty Program** are accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) since 2009.

UM Shore Medical Center at Easton is designated as a **Cardiac Interventional Center** by Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS).

University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown

A 12-bed hospital in Chestertown providing inpatient and outpatient services, including specialty care, surgical services, oncology, inpatient dialysis, emergency services, diagnostic imaging and rehabilitation services.

University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Dorchester

A 34-bed hospital in Cambridge providing inpatient and outpatient services and a 12-bed behavioral health unit. (Scheduled for closure in late 2021, after the opening of UM Shore Medical Campus at Cambridge.)

University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton

A 135-bed hospital in Easton providing inpatient and outpatient services, a pain care clinic, sleep disorders center, diabetes care, primary stroke center, emergency services, diagnostic and imaging services, palliative care and comprehensive medical rehabilitation.

University of Maryland Shore Emergency Center at Queenstown

With 11 treatment rooms and 24-hour-a-day care by board-certified emergency medicine physicians, experienced nurses, radiology technicians and medical technologists, the Center treats an average of 16,000 patients each year. It also offers coordinated ambulance and helicopter transport as needed for patients who must be admitted to inpatient care.

Orthopedic Care

UM Shore Regional Health partners with The Orthopedic Center to offer a multi-specialty approach to treatment and rehabilitation for conditions related to the neck, spine, hands, feet and joints, including hips and knees.

PHYSICIAN NETWORK

UM Shore Medical Group employs physicians and advanced practice providers who offer extensive experience in primary care and in specialties including behavioral health, breast health, cardiology, diabetes and endocrinology, gastroenterology, otorhinolaryngology (ENT), neurology, neurosurgery, pain care, palliative care, pediatrics, pulmonary care, radiation oncology, rehabilitation, surgical care, urology, women's health and wound care.
