

Neurosurgery Team Plans Mission Trip to Honduras

Dr. Khalid Kurtom and members of his neurosurgery team are planning a trip to Honduras in January 2020 to work with One World Surgery to perform life-changing neurosurgical procedures at the Holy Family Surgery Center in Honduras.

The purpose of the weeklong medical mission is to provide minimally invasive neurosurgical procedures to Honduras residents who would otherwise not have access to quality surgical care. These procedures will treat certain types of spinal conditions including degenerative or herniated disc disorders, lumbar spinal stenosis, instability of the spine and compression fractures of the spine.
